Additional Information Required

1. You will need to complete a Notice of Intended Marriage Form. This may be completed any time within eighteen months before the marriage but must be completed at least one month before the marriage takes place.
2. Birth Certificates (or Extracts from Birth Certificates) must be produced when the Notice of Intended Marriage Form is handed to the priest.
This also applies to other documents which are required in special circumstances.
3. At least one member of the marriage couple should be baptised into the Christian faith.
4. The names of the witnesses (usually the best man and chief bridesmaid) will be required before the wedding in order to complete the Marriage Forms.

Preparing for a Wedding at Nambour Parish

There are at least 3 or 4 meetings with the Celebrant/Minister prior to the wedding.

- We ask the couple to complete a pre-marriage couple inventory that will give help each other in the relationship side of the marriage. This can be discussed with the pastor/counsellor.
- We offer study material about the natural of Christian marriage for the couple to use.
- The application of Christian faith to marriage will be discussed.
- The marriage service is planned with the couple.
- If either of the parties have been previously divorced an application to the Bishop is required, and no definite plans can be made until permission is received.

Close to the wedding there is a rehearsal for the bridal party.
